Claire Adele Beckwith Livingston, 96 of Athens, passed away on Monday, August 31, 2020. Mrs. Livingston was born June of 1924 in Hartford, CT to Rexford Fillmore Beckwith and Bertha Josephine Dowd.

Mrs. Livingston graduated from Providence Bible Institute in R.I. and from NYU-Bellvue Nursing School where she received her diploma and RN License. In 1983 she spent 4 years in Jerusalem, Israel running the Christian Missionary Alliance Guest House. Claire and her husband spent over 40 years leading tours to the Holy Land. In 2000 she and her husband went to Omaha, NE, where she assisted him in the ministry to senior adults at Christ Community Church. She loved to read and enjoyed sports. She was an avid walker and volunteered for the Red Cross earning a Lifetime Red Cross Pin.

She is survived by her husband of 66 years, Robert Lucas Livingston; daughter, Ruth Livingston Guertin (Jon); son, Stephen Joel Livingston;

brother, Bruce Beckwith (Louise); grandson, Matthew Lucas Guertin (Jamie); granddaughters, Jessica Brittany Wainio (Steve) and Ashley Faith Guertin; great grandchildren, Abigail Grace Guertin and Benjamin Alexander Guertin; numerous nieces and nephews.
