He had a special talent for cosmetology, graduating from Paul Mitchell the School with a Master's in Cosmetology and was state certified/licensed. Near the end of his life, he had the gift of working with special needs children who came to the specialty children's salon where he worked.

Daniel will always be remembered for his resilience, his tenacity, his gentleness, his kindness and for his deep love for family and friends. Daniel had a heart for always trying to help solve problems and the needs of those he loved. Daniel will be missed now and forevermore and loved everlastingly.

He leaves behind for his partner three kitties: Toph, Kara and Monkey and his beloved dog, Lilo.

A celebration of life will be held on his birthday, November 30, 2025, between 2-4 PM at 110 Winter Wood Drive South, Murfreesboro, TN 37129.

“ I met Daniel in high school, and he was my and Courtney's prom date. We became good friends, but I moved away after high school, so I only saw him when I came into town.

I moved back in 2017, and that's when we got closer. Daniel and I started going on adventures together: holiday parties, downtown, haunted houses, day trips, Pride - he was always down for anything.

One day we went swimming and we talked about our twenties. We both had this epiphany that we're basically the same person. Every year we would dye our hair, move to a new city, and change jobs. We never stayed in one place for too long. We felt things too deeply. We felt too much all the time. We experienced the highest of highs and the lowest of lows. We discovered that we both have bipolar disorder. Daniel moved away, but we messaged and visited whenever he came into town.

In 2021, I had the hardest year of my life. I was a new mom and my entire life imploded. I lost my relationship, my home, and my job in a matter of months. I had no money, close family, or support system. Friends were there for me, but everyone had a lot going on. I went to a mental hospital in January 2022.

After I got back home, I called Daniel one night and we stayed up until 2am talking on the phone for hours. Then we talked the next night, and then the next day, and then the day after that. It became a part of our day. Everyday we'd talk on the phone for hours. We'd talk on work breaks, in the car, at the grocery store, when I was at the park with my son Devis, late night when he would sit outside smoking cigarettes and spying on his neighbors, lol.

In one of the darkest times in my life, when I couldn't see the light at the end of the tunnel, when I felt more alone than I've ever felt - Daniel was only a phone call away. I couldn't have made it without him. His heart is so full, and he loves his family and friends so much. Words can't express how lucky I feel that I had a friend like

Daniel.
