Doris Jean Loggins Walker passed away on February 14, 2023, surrounded by her family. Doris was born on June 6, 1941, in Piney Chapel, Alabama. She is preceded in death by her beloved husband Jimmy Burl Walker, her father William Wesley Loggins Jr., her mother Margaret Leona Pirtle Loggins, and her infant brother Milton Wesley Loggins. (professional society for women educators), active member of Alabama Educators Association (AEA), and President of Athens-Limestone Education Retirees Association.

Doris was a lifelong devoted member of Ephesus Church of Christ. She was an avid baker, loved to travel, read, and spend time with her family on Elk River. On Sunday, February 19, 2023, Doris' service will include a visitation beginning at Noon and a celebration of life at 2 pm at Limestone Chapel Funeral Home with interment at Roselawn Cemetery to follow.
