Jesse Price "Shep" Evans, Jr., age 85 of Elkmont, passed away Thursday, June 20, 2013. Mr. Evans was born November 17, 1927, in Limestone County to Jesse Price Evans, Sr., and Cludia Mae Stepp Evans.
