To the Family: It was an absolute pleasure and honor meeting her. Thank you for that, she will be and is missed so much. My deepest condolences. She would talk about all of you.

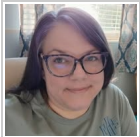

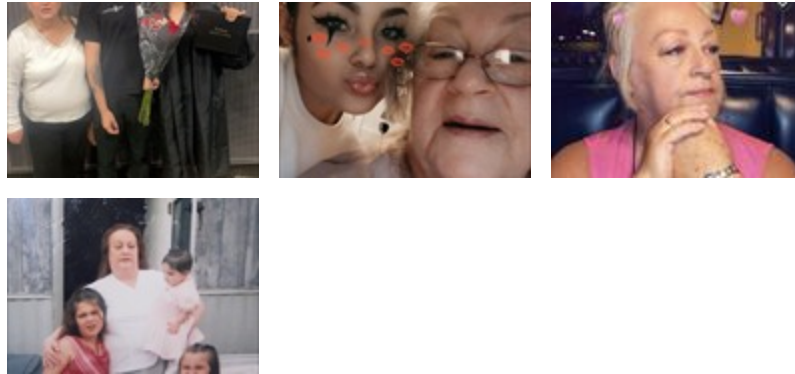
