Lillian Nell (Sutton) Bradford, 78, of Decatur, AL, passed away on August 23, 2017 in Tallahassee, FL. She was born on August 1, 1939 in Danville, AL, and was the third of seven children born to James Monroe Sutton and Myrtle Leona (Pace) Sutton.
