Luther "Rick" Woodall, 75, of Athens, Alabama, left this world to be with his Heavenly Father on Saturday, March 16, 2024, at Huntsville Hospital. Rick was born on September 26, 1948, in Morton, Arkansas, to parents Luther P. Woodall and Edrie M. Dickerson Woodall, and grew up in Pumpkin Bend, Arkansas.
