Lyndon Joel Campbell II age 60 of Athens, passed away on Sunday, March 17, 2013 at Huntsville Hospital. Lyndon was born January 17, 1953 in St. Louis Missouri to Lyndon Campbell and Marilyn Hawkins Campbell. Services for Dr. Campbell are Friday, March 22, 2013 at Lindsay Lane Baptist Church at 2:30 p.m. with Rusty Nelson officiating. Visitation will be Friday, March 22, 2013 from 11:00 until 2:15 p.m. at the church. There will be a private family burial. Limestone Chapel Funeral Home is handling the arrangements.
