Marian Jeanette Meunitz Hatfield, 80, died Thursday, December 2, 2010 at Athens Limestone Hospital.

Visitation will be Friday, December 10, 2010 from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. at Limestone Chapel Funeral Home. A memorial service will be held Saturday, December 11, 2010 at 11:00 a.m. Burial will be at Gatlin Cemetery in Ardmore, AL.

Marian was born October 22, 1930 in Milwaukee, WI to Harry and Rachel Meunitz. The family moved to Los Angeles, CA in 1947. She graduated from high school and served as a W.A.V.E. in the U.S. Navy from 1952 to 1954 during the Korean War.
