Mrs. Mitchell made it her goal to honor God and her husband by cultivating the “incorruptible beauty of a quiet and gentle spirit which is very precious in the sight of God.” (I Peter 3:4) Billy and Nellie Dean were blessed with two daughters, Lisa and Kathy whom they raised to be servants of God. She enjoyed helping care for her grandchildren. Mrs. Mitchell was a tender-hearted, conscientious, soft-spoken, gentle lady who always had her giggly-girl happiness ready to share with her loved ones. She was willing to stand firm in God’s Truth even when met with opposition. Nellie Dean’s fervent desire was to support Gospel preaching, help the needy, and she always wanted everyone to be right with God. She was a humble, modest person both in her clothing and her behavior. Billy and Nellie Dean became members of the newly begun Jackson Drive Church of Christ in September 1966 and remained so until her passing.
