Tim Coffman of Athens, AL, passed away peacefully at his home on January 12, 2022, after a brief illness.

Tim was a lifelong resident of Athens and business owner for forty (40) years, serving his community and the state. He started his business in 1982 and built it from the ground up, surpassing even his own dreams of success to ultimately become one of the most trusted and sought-after service businesses in Alabama.
