Memorial Services for Tommy Rost 67, of Athens will be Saturday, January 14, 2012, 2:00 p.m. at First Christian Church. Visitation will be Saturday from 12:30 p.m. until 2:00 p.m. at the church prior to the service. A private burial will be held prior to the visitation.
