



## Wynette Griggs Chittam

December 12, 1936 - January 8, 2021

Wynette Griggs Chittam, age 84, passed away peacefully at Huntsville Hospital surrounded by her three daughters on Friday, January 8, 2021, from complications related to her 2016 cancer diagnosis.
